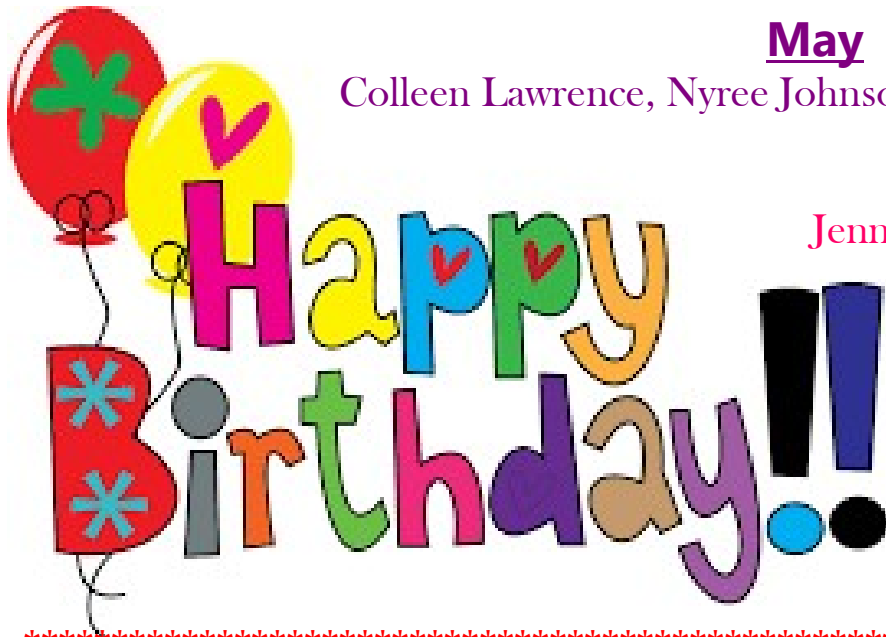

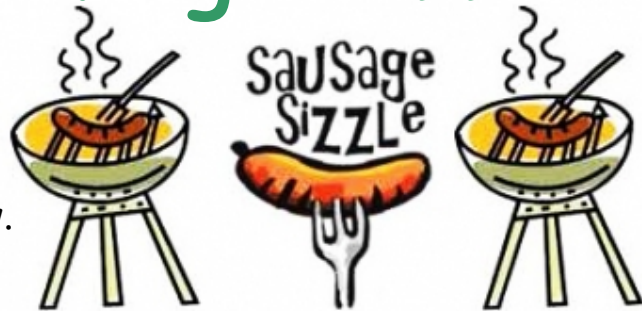


We sure have a few of these!!

In winter the game will start around 3.30pm and finish around 5pm with a sausage sizzle to follow.



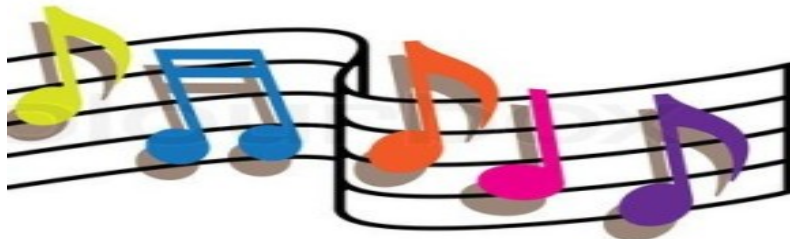
In the summer months we will start a bit later to give workers a chance to play.
